SUBJECT: TRADOC Policy Letter #25, Commander's Safety Statement

1. Reference AR 385-10 (The Army Safety Program), 27 November 2013.
2. The Army is in transition, and TRADOC has an increasingly important role in helping inform and guide that transition. As the Architect of the Army, we must be prepared to accept the challenge of continuing to train today's Army as we build the Force of 2025 and beyond. This responsibility calls for difficult decisions at all levels as we balance risk and mission accomplishments to meet the needs of our current and Future Force.
3. All leaders, including TRADOC leaders, have an obligation for continuous risk management. Ours is unique based on our role in building, developing, and training the force, but equally important for the well-being of our Soldiers and Civilians. Your efforts to integrate risk management on a daily basis in our training and operations demonstrate your commitment to Soldiers' welfare.
4. Safety is training in TRADOC, and your commitment to risk management ensures the safety and welfare of our Soldiers and Civilians. By incorporating risk management into all aspects of training, we clearly demonstrate to Soldiers and leaders what right looks like. It is one more standard established in our schools, captured in our doctrine, and instilled in the force.
