SUBJECT: TRADOC Policy Letter 28, Implementation of Approved AR 15-6 Investigation Recommendations

1. Reference Army Regulation (AR) 15-6 (Procedures for Investigating Officers and Boards of Officers), 30 September 1996, Rapid Action Revision issued 2 October 2006.
2. I am committed to ensuring approved AR 15-6 investigation recommendations throughout TRADOC are implemented. Implementation of recommendations will result in improved processes and procedures and ensure other approved actions are taken. This policy requires commanders at all levels to establish policies to ensure implementation of approved AR 15-6 investigation recommendations in their commands. For investigations appointed by TRADOC at the general officer level, this policy creates a staffing mechanism to assist subordinate commanders to implement approved recommendations.
3. After approval of an AR 15-6 investigation appointed by a general officer assigned to this headquarters, the TRADOC Office of the Staff Judge Advocate (OSJA) will provide specific deliverable information (Lead, Assist, and Info, product required, suspense date, and point of contact) to the TRADOC Office of the Secretary of the General Staff (OSGS) for tasking to relevant subordinate commands, staffs, or activities for implementation. OSGS will then task the appropriate TRADOC entities with implementation of recommendations, and coordinate with the TRADOC OSJA to ensure the action is completed.
4. To ensure sensitive information is safeguarded, full investigations will not be distributed with taskings. Substantive documents will be provided by the TRADOC OSJA to the relevant subordinate supporting legal office(s) to distribute as appropriate.
5. This policy is intended to create a tool to ensure recommendations are implemented. It does not relieve commanders of the responsibility to implement recommendations.
6. This policy letter is effective until superseded or rescinded.
