


Individual Development Plan (IDP)

Creating an IDP allows users to track all aspects of their career using a standard template. Using the ACT IDP users have the ability to map out events, decision points and outcomes. A pathway to success is established to create short and long term goals. ACT allows users to measure their progress against known benchmarks.
