We have provided the information below to help ease your transition and prepare you for a successful beginning to your Army Civilian career here at TRADOC.

• If you need access to your facility, your Sponsor can assist you until you receive your Common Access (CAC) card as well as a post map.

• Directions for obtaining your CAC card are provided on the onboarding webpage, but if you already have a CAC card, it is suggested that you keep it until you receive a new one to electronically sign essential documents and expedite your inprocessing.

• If you already have a CAC from another DOD Civilian agency, you may choose to utilize it until it expires.

• Be sure to have any accounts from your former installation deprovisioned so that your new accounts can be established in a timely manner. Discuss with your IMO.

• If possible, we suggest you bring a personal laptop so that you can access necessary training until you receive your government-issued equipment and obtain network access.

We hope you find this information helpful. Remember, your sponsor is here for you and available should you have any questions or require assistance before your first day.
